



TRACK RULES

Risks are always a part of any sport or physical activities. To ensure that your karting experience stays memorable for the right reasons, we have put in place specific rules to all participants. These rules are meant to assure you the utmost safety. Offenders to those rules will receive appropriate sanctions. If you are the organizer of a mini Grand-Prix, please transmit these to all participants.

1. No contact will be tolerated
2. Always wear your helmet
3. Only full face helmets with shields are allowed
4. Shield must be down when entering the track
5. Drive very slowly in the pit lane
6. Yield when entering the track
7. To go off the track may bring expulsion
8. It is forbidden to stop on the track
9. It is forbidden to manipulate the engine
10. It is forbidden to cross the track when karts are running

SRA Karting officials may refuse access to the track to any person endangering other's safety, or causing damage to the equipment or to SRA Karting International premises. People under alcohol or drug influence will not be allowed to drive. SRA Karting officials may stop a session at any time for any reason.
